Participation Guidelines

Performers

- All performers will receive a participation gift.
- Priority will be given to SRJC students.
- Alumni, faculty, staff, family, public will be able to participate as space allows.
- Open to any talent, encouraged to align with **La Carpa** theme.
- Provide a short statement of how performance will adhere to [La Carpa theme](#).
- One registration form per act.
 - ✓ Main contact person should fill out the form.
- **This year, performers will need to submit a casting video of the act, or a link to a video already on YouTube, Vimeo or any other social media platform.**
 - ✓ Make sure your video is no longer than 2 minutes – you don't have to perform the whole act.
 - ✓ Video submission is limited to a size less of **25 MB**.
 - ✓ Make sure your video does not contain inappropriate language, images, or sounds.
 - ✓ Make sure you say your full name and a short description of your performance.
 - ✓ Make sure your video file is labeled with your first and last name for identification.
- **Registration will close on September 15, 2023 at 5pm.**
- If using music or other forms of media, required to send on week before the event.
- **Acts are limited to 3-4 minutes.**
- Commit to participate on the day of event, and during the rehearsal, the day prior to the event.

Audience

- **The show is free.** Donations are encouraged and accepted to help pay for future events.
- Seating will be limited, **first-come-first-serve.**
- Doors open at 5:30pm.
- The audience is invited to dress up according to [La Carpa theme](#).

- Volunteers need to commit to be present at 6-8 pm the day of rehearsal, October 12
